1931 Ralph Walker - designed art-deco tower, which began its life as the headquarters of the Irving Trust, is now the largest office-to-condo conversion in New York City history and features 100,000 square feet of luxury amenities. Riffing off the striking landmarked lobby of fire reds and gold handmade mosaics, the amenities spaces push the conversation to a light filled, serene and surreal space on top of the New York City downtown world.
