activities and two hotels – Hotel Termas and Hotel Parque – interconnected by a covered pedestrian bridge. The spa offers a wellbeing circuit characterized stylistically by evocations of Roman decorative motifs, with the same elegance, taste, and richness. In this choice, an important role was played by the SICIS mosaic collections in the saunas, Turkish baths, showers and relaxation rooms, interpreting the spirit of the place with perfect equilibrium.
